



## QATAR FOUNDATION VEHICLE ACCESS PERMIT CONDITIONS

### TRAFFIC and PARKING CONTROL POLICY

1. By applying for, accepting and displaying a Qatar Foundation Vehicle Access Permit the owner/driver has agreed to abide by the conditions stated in this document.
2. All staff, students or dependants wishing to drive a vehicle within Education City will require a vehicle access permit on their vehicle.
3. The vehicle permit shall be placed on the dash board on the lower left side of the vehicles windshield such that the permit is clearly visible for the security staff. Drivers will comply with traffic and safety directions from the security staff, those not complying will have their vehicle number recorded as an infraction.
4. Driver and passengers will be required to show their Qatar Foundation or Centre identification at the security check point. The permit may also be checked to ensure the license and registration information is correct and valid.
5. Passengers or visitors without Qatar Foundation identification will be required to register and produce alternative photo identification.
6. Depending upon the security situation, security staff may request to search the vehicle. If permission is not granted by the driver to search the vehicle, access to the site will be denied.
7. Permit holders will drive safely and obey all Qatari traffic laws while on Qatar Foundation property. Racing, reckless or stunt driving on Qatar Foundation property is strictly prohibited, failure to comply will result in the **immediate cancellation** of the vehicle access and driving privileges on site.
8. Speed limit in Education City is 40 kph on road and 10 kph in parking lots or roads adjacent to schools unless otherwise posted. Speed will be monitored by electronic means. Speeding is an offence and will be recorded.
9. Safety belts will be worn at all times in accordance with Qatari traffic law.
10. Vehicles may only park in designated parking areas. Parking in areas not designated as parking or marked as no parking is an offence and will be recorded.
11. Parking in a parking space reserved for disabled, when neither the driver nor passengers are disabled is an offence and will be recorded. Vehicles may be clamped or towed.
12. Permit holders will return the vehicle permit if they no longer have a requirement for driving access to Education City.
13. The permit is not transferable to another vehicle, driver or owner. Permit holders will immediately report the loss or theft of the vehicle permit to Qatar Foundation Security.
14. After three recorded infractions or offences the vehicle access permit will be revoked and the driver will lose the privilege of being allowed to drive any vehicle on site.

The person applying and signing for the vehicle access permit acknowledges that they understand and accept the responsibility of ensuring that they or any driver of the registered vehicle shall comply with the preceding traffic rules and conditions as stated herein.
