Acknowledgement of State of Qatar Immigration Medical Clearance Requirements

To study and reside in Qatar, a residency permit is required for all students. The issuance of the residency permit is contingent upon clearance of all medical examinations.

All students requiring a visa to attend Carnegie Mellon University Qatar are required by the Ministry of Public Health to take a medical exam, for the purposes of obtaining their residency permit and to protect the health of the population and prevent the spread of infectious diseases.

Medical clearance is defined by negative test results for the following tests:

- Tuberculosis
- HIV antibodies
- Hepatitis B
- Hepatitis C

Positive findings on any of the above tests may result in repatriation from the country.

We strongly recommend that you have these tests done in your home country prior to your arrival in Qatar to verify that you do not have any of the above-mentioned medical conditions.

Please note that the test results students independently obtain in their home country will not be used for immigration processing. The State of Qatar's Medical Commission will perform the tests again after students arrive in Doha and those results will be considered as final and official.
